Maneuverable and versatile, the 100-guest *Pacific Explorer* is the perfect way to travel in comfort throughout your Central American adventures.

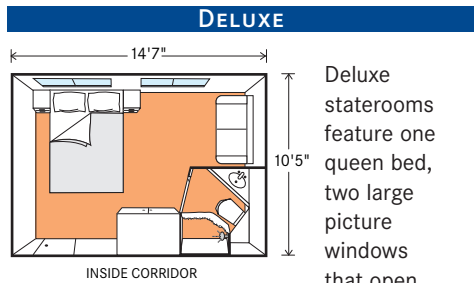
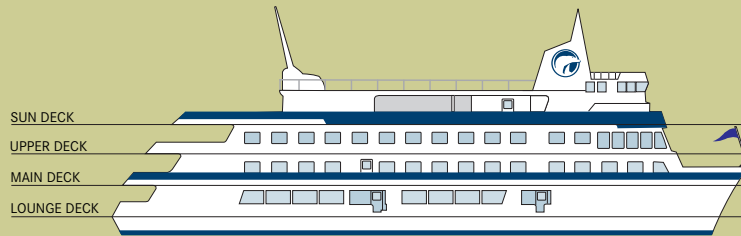

Deluxe staterooms are extra-spacious, with two large view windows.

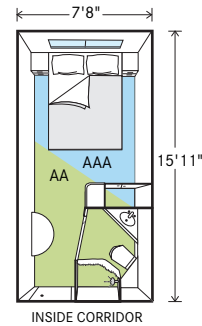


AAA and AA staterooms feature large view windows that open.



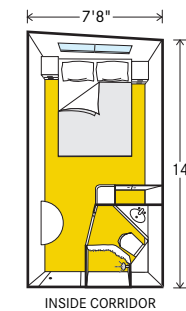

CATEGORY AAA/AA



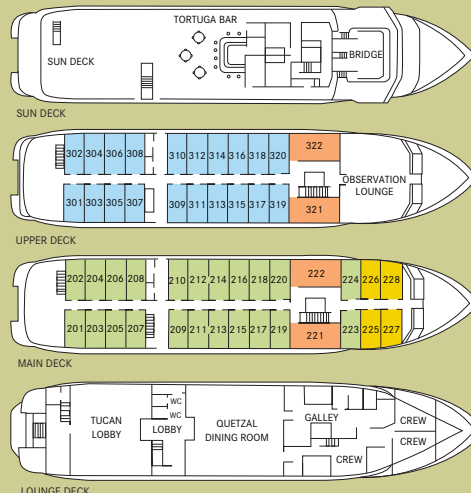
AAA cabins in the Upper Deck and AA cabins on the Main Deck offer one queen or two twin beds, a picture window that opens, storage closet and shelves, and private facilities. Cabins 212 & 214, 211 & 213 may be adjoined. Cabins 203, 204, 211, 212, 303, 304, 311, 312, 315 and 316 have double beds.

A cabins, forward on the Main Deck, offer one queen bed, a picture window that opens, storage closet and shelves, and private facilities. Cabins 225, 226, 227 and 228 have double beds.
