

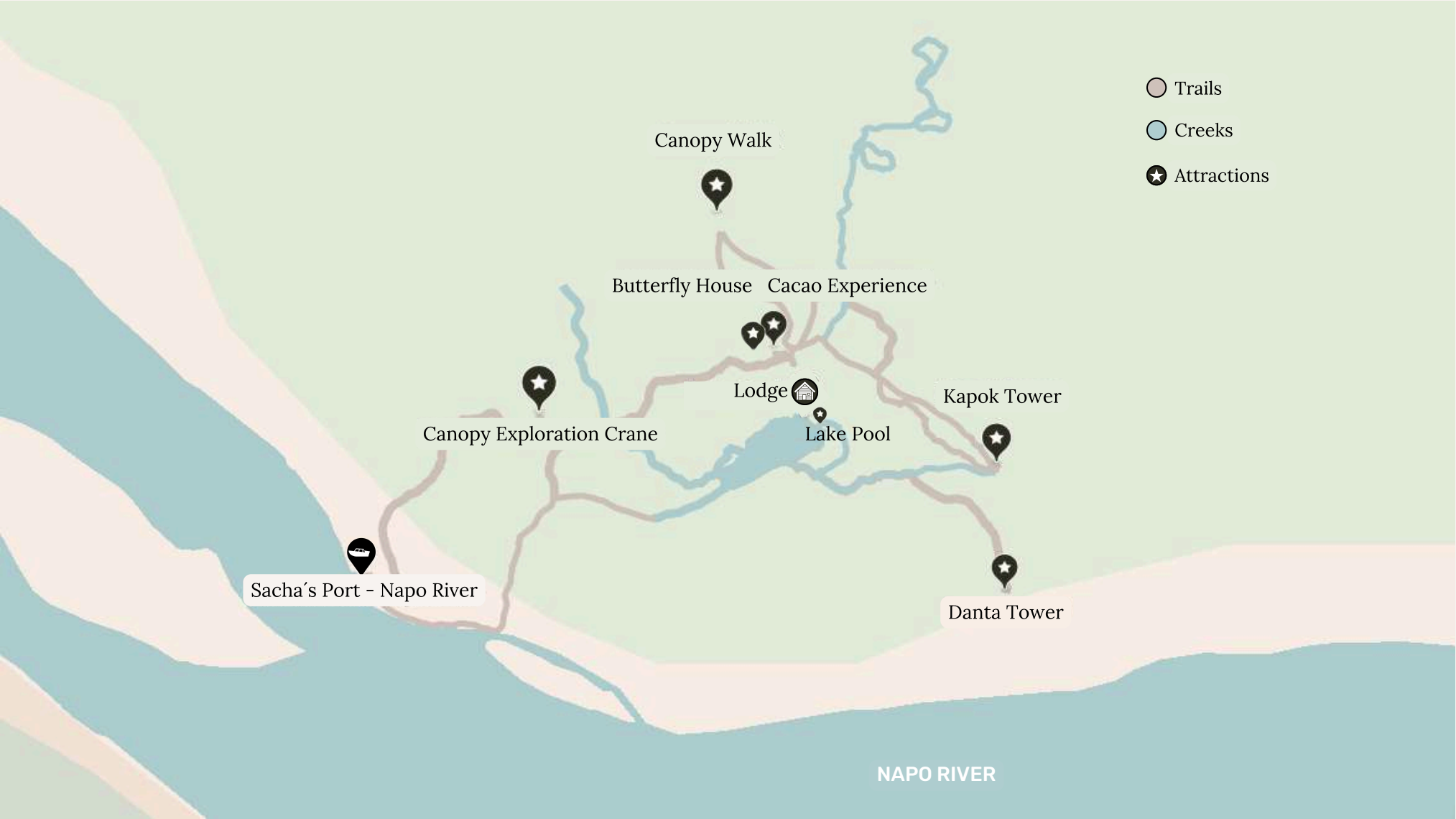

SIGNATURE CANOPY EXPERIENCES


Canopy Walk

Explore the rainforest canopy along a 94-foot-high (36 meters) bridge above the treetops! This 940-foot-long (275 meters) sturdy walkway connects three towers, offering an astounding opportunity to spot dozens of animals.

Canopy Exploration Crane


Take a high-flying ride up 150 feet (45 meters) above the forest floor into the canopy of the amazing Amazon Rainforest in a hot air balloon-like basket. Explore nearly 2 acres (.78 hectares) of rainforest canopy with its 150-foot (45-meter) long boom.

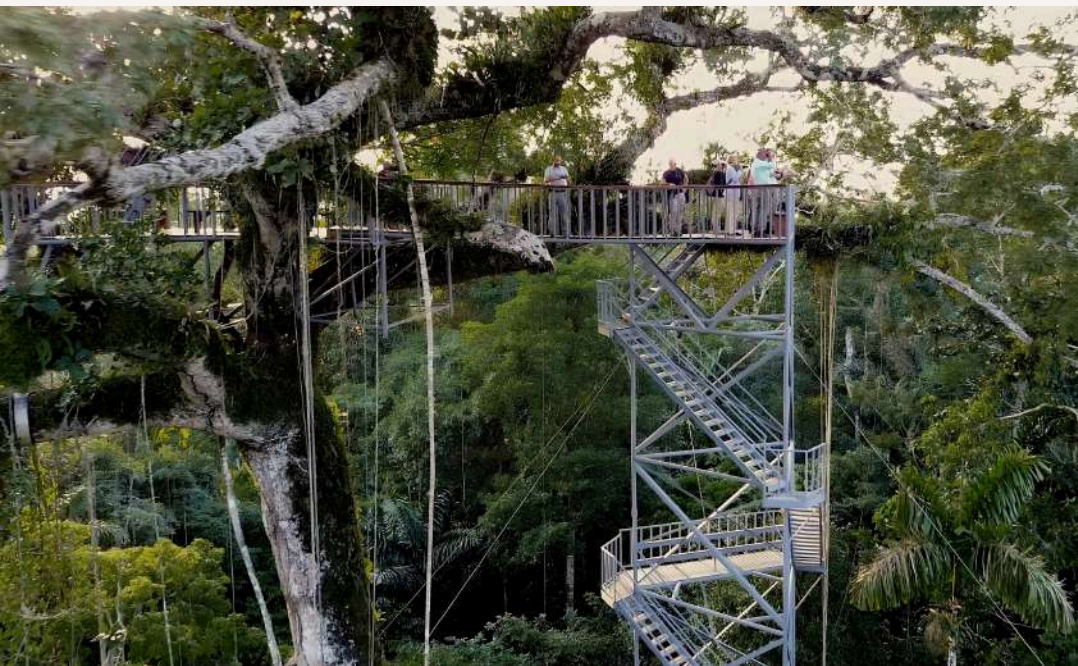

Kapok Tower

You'll feel like you're on the very top of the world on our 135-foot (43-meter) observation tower, a platform built on the highest branches of a giant kapok tree.

Danta Tower


Nestled within the canopy of a lush swamp habitat, this 72-foot (22-meter) high tower offers an intimate perspective of the rainforest's mid-story

Morning Forest Walk

Creeping along jungle paths, your naturalist guide might take you through the territory of crested owls or howler monkeys, mimicking the creatures' calls to win their trust and coax them out of hiding.

Night Forest Walk

When darkness falls, have your flashlight ready to spot creatures of the night such as tarantulas, frogs, boas and stick insects while the rainforest symphony unfolds around you.

Creek Paddling

Creek paddling in dug-out canoes is a fabulous adventure, with the bonus that it requires little physical exertion. Paddling down the streams is like entering a tunnel leading into a lost world.

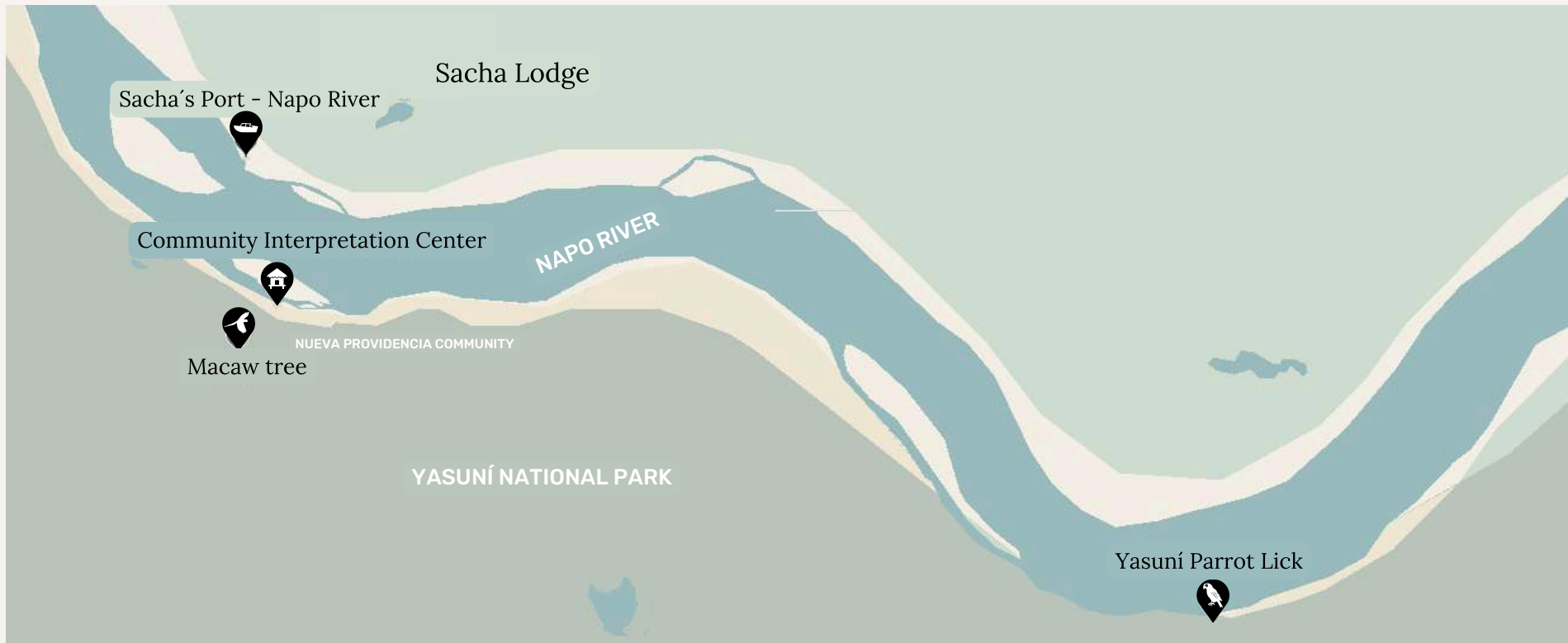


BEYOND SACHA'S RESERVE


On select days, guests venture beyond our private reserve for an excursion to Yasuní's Parrot Clay Lick, the Macaw Tree, and the Community Interpretation Center at Nueva Providencia Community. This is a shared activity between the groups of guests that sign up. Guests may choose to participate in individual excursions or combine them. The visits to the Yasuní Parrot Lick and the Macaw Lick are offered on Wednesdays and Sundays only.

Full-Day Yasuní


Available only for bookings with a private guide confirmed at the time of reservation (private guiding cannot be added for this excursion only), or when all guests in the assigned group(s) agree to participate.


Cross the Napo River and step into the forest trails of Yasuní National Park, within the territory of the Nueva Providencia Community. This area is known for the Golden-mantled Tamarin and Spider Monkey, which you may have the chance to encounter along the walk.

Throughout this full-day excursion, keep your eyes open for possible sightings of Scarlet and Blue-and-yellow macaws.

Midday, enjoy a snack and a boxed lunch in the rainforest before continuing with the walk. A native guide from the Nueva Providencia Community accompanies the experience, offering local insight along the way.

Lake Pool

Our plunge pool, the only one of its kind in the Amazon region, is protected on all sides by a mesh cage that allows you to cool off in the black waters of Pilchicocha Lake without fear of encountering the unknown. You may even spot a caiman or giant otters swimming by on the other side of the net!

Butterfly House

The Butterfly House was designed as a live exhibition conservatory, where guests will be shown how these beautiful insects are bred and raised. Later, roam through “the flying room” where hundreds of colorful butterflies flutter from flower to flower.

Cacao Experience


This activity invites guests to explore the traditional art of chocolate-making—from harvesting and roasting to grinding and tasting your very own creation. Set in a charming, native-style house, the experience is fully immersed in the lush surroundings of Sacha Lodge's private reserve, offering a hands-on journey into the flavors and culture of the Amazon.

Your guide will teach you how to fish for the infamous razor-toothed piranha. You can ask your guide to coordinate this activity during your free time at the lodge.

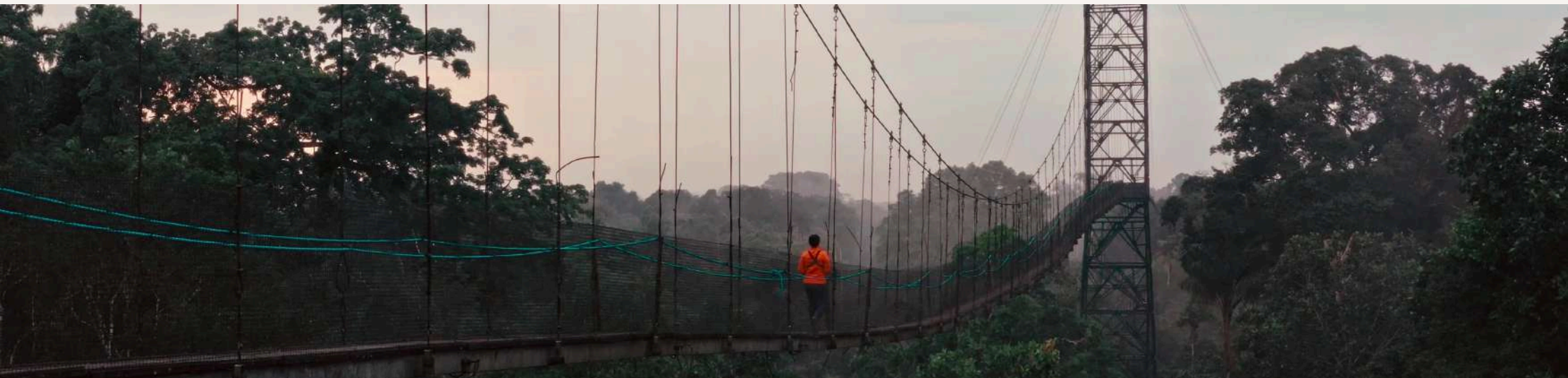

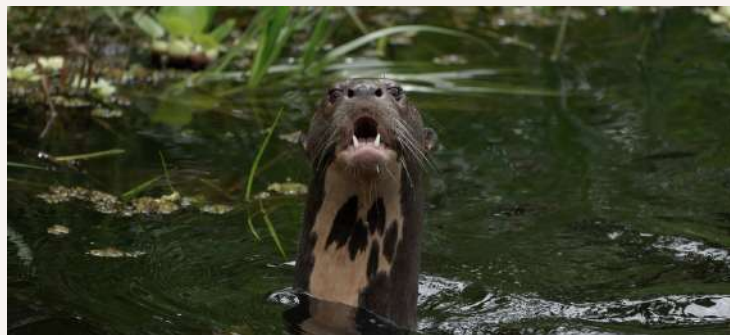


IMPORTANT NOTES

- Guests are organized into small groups of up to six. A private guide is available for an additional charge and must be arranged during the booking process.
- While activities offer flexibility, daily coordination with the assigned guide and group at the lodge is required.
- If a group traveling together prefers not to be divided, excursions may operate with up to eight guests; however, smaller groups improve wildlife viewing opportunities.
- Rubber boots and rain ponchos are provided when necessary. Guides carry telescopes during excursions. Individual binoculars are available for rent at the Lodge (additional cost).
- Parrot Clay Lick and Macaw Tree visits are offered on Wednesdays and Sundays only (weather permitting). Sacha Lodge does not charge for these visits; a USD \$10 community contribution for the Macaw Tree is paid locally. (cash only)
- The Native Community Interpretation Center visit requires a USD 10 contribution, paid locally (cash only).
- Full-Day Yasuní is available only for bookings with a private guide confirmed at the time of reservation (private guiding cannot be added for this excursion only), or when all guests in the assigned excursion group(s) agree to participate.
- Sacha Lodge is located in a protected nature reserve. Guests must follow staff and guide instructions at all times. The Lodge is not liable for incidents resulting from failure to follow safety guidelines or undisclosed health or mobility conditions.
- Activity times are approximate. The length of excursions may vary depending on group interests, pace, fitness level, weather, or safety considerations. Excursions may be modified or rescheduled due to weather or safety needs, without refund.
- Wildlife sightings are not guaranteed. To protect natural behaviors, Sacha Lodge does not use feeders to attract birds or other animals. All encounters occur in the wild, supporting sustainable and authentic experiences.
- Wildlife viewing must always respect natural distance. Feeding, touching, or attempting any physical interaction with animals is strictly prohibited.
- Photography must never disturb wildlife. Flash, aggressive positioning, or attempts to provoke movement are not permitted, ensuring animals remain undisturbed in their habitat.
- The use of drones is prohibited for the protection and safety of the rainforest's wildlife.
