
### Manaus - Villa Amazônia

## Program - 05 Days and 04 Nights

### Day 1 – Rio de Janeiro - Arrival

#### Transfer from International Rio de Janeiro Airport to Hotel (Private Transfer - Duration – 01 hours)

Upon arrival in Rio de Janeiro, meet & greet by an English speaking local guide and transfer to hotel.

Check in at Hotel.

### Day 2 – Rio de Janeiro

Breakfast at hotel.

#### Ful day – Corcovado and Sugar Loaf with Stop for lunch (Private tour – Duration: 8 hours)

The passengers will leave your hotel for a full-day tour, passing through the beaches of Rio, taking you from Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas to the Cosme Velho neighborhood. There you'll board the Swiss-made cogwheel train for a scenic ride through Tijuca National Park until you reach the 710-meter summit of Corcovado. At the top of the mountain, carved in soapstone mosaic in the best art deco style, is Christ the Redeemer, a 38-meter-tall statue with arms outstretched as if it were a blessing to the city. The view from Corcovado offers a spectacular panorama of Rio and its surroundings. You will quickly understand why Rio is called the Marvelous City. After visiting Corcovado, you'll board the train to Cosme Velho station and head for lunch at a local steakhouse. The "churrasco" is a traditional way of preparing meat in southern Brazil (and Argentina). Guests will have the opportunity to try an infinite variety of meats served continuously, various side dishes and salads. After lunch, we will leave to the Urca neighborhood to board the cable car for a two-stage trip that will take us to Sugarloaf Mountain. In the first stage, Morro da Urca, with only 220 m high, there is a restaurant, amphitheater and heliport for panoramic tours. The second stage takes us to Pão de Açúcar, named after the sugar bars that the Portuguese used to use at the time of the discovery of the city. From both places, guests will have a wonderful view of the most famous places in Rio, such as the beaches of Copacabana, Ipanema and Leblon, as well as Botafogo and Flamengo that lead to the city center, Christ the Redeemer and the Rio-Niterói bridge. At any time of day or night, the view from Sugarloaf Mountain is extraordinarily beautiful, making Sugarloaf Mountain, without a doubt, one of the most famous places in the city. After visiting the Sugar Loaf Mountain, the tour continues towards the downtown with a stop at the Metropolitan Cathedral, a large cone-shaped building with impressive stained-glass windows. After this visit, a quick panoramic view of downtown Rio and return to the hotel.

#### Lunch at Carretão Ipanema Brazilian Barbecue Restaurant (Not Included)

The "churrasco" is a traditional Brazilian southern (and Argentinean) way of preparing the meats. The guests will have the opportunity of tasting an endless variety of meat served continuously, several garnish and salads. After desert, a Brazilian coffee will be served to complete the typical gastronomic experience. Barbecue and salad buffet, drinks not included. Return to hotel.

Meals: Breakfast included.

### Day 3 – Rio de Janeiro

Breakfast at hotel.

#### Rio Downtown & Carnival Experience (Private Tour – Duration: 6 hours)

This tour combines the historic highlights of downtown Rio with the modern attractions in the Porto Maravilha area including the Olympic Boulevard. We start by driving until the Center of the City and visit the Metropolitan Cathedral. Then we continue to Cinelândia area to see the Municipal Theater, National Library, and the fine arts museum. On the Port area we will be able to see the Street Murals of Kobra Art. Eduardo Kobra is a muralist that creates works that simulate dimensions. From this tour we will arrive at Samba Schools warehouses, we will have a guided tour and learn about the history of samba and carnival parades by entering the samba atmosphere by trying on a few authentic carnival costumes, while enjoying a Caipirinha drink. The tour continues towards the downtown with a stop at the Metropolitan Cathedral, a large cone-shaped construction with impressive stained-glass windows. After this visit return to the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast included.

### Day 4 – Rio de Janeiro to Manaus

Breakfast and check out at hotel.

#### Transfer from Hotel to International Rio de Janeiro Airport

Arrival in Manaus.

#### Transfer from International Manaus Airport to hotel.

Check in at hotel

#### Manaus Historical City tour (Private Tour – Duration: 04 hours)

During the journey, we will show you the old part of the city where we will remember the golden era of rubber when Manaus had the opportunity to experience the splendor of wealth that presented our city with countless monuments and buildings with a lot of luxury and beauty. They will visit the square of the old City Hall of Manaus. Then we will visit the City Museum that is located inside the building of the old City Hall of Manaus, we will visit the floating Port of Manaus (the only one of its kind in the country) built by the British in exchange of an administration that lasted 60 years, completely renovated, with a beautiful terminal to house the countless passengers who pass through it daily to board and disembark the various boats coming and going to numerous cities in the interior of the Amazon, as well as receiving many transatlantic liners that visit Manaus. Further on, you can see the Adolpho Lisboa Municipal Market, which is a miniature replica of the extinct "Les Hales de Paris" market (Baltard pavilion). Where you can also see the countless fish, fruits, herbs and different types of manioc flour consumed by the population. We will pass in front of the Rio Negro Palace, which was the private residence of a Rubber Baron, we will make a short stop for photos and finally, we will see the famous Teatro Amazonas built over a hundred years ago with all the material imported from Europe, its majesty in the middle of the Largo de São Sebastião portrays the luxurious time that the city lived. After this visit, we will return to the hotel or in the case of a city tour in the morning, we can also end up at a restaurant in the city for lunch (not included) and return to hotel.

Available from Tuesday to Saturday - (morning and afternoon) and Sunday morning only.



#### Day 5 –Manaus

Breakfast at hotel.

#### Visit the Indigenous Community with Ritual and Lunh (Private Tour – Duration: 5 hours)

Departure from the hotel by vehicle to the port of Marina do Davi where they will board a speedboat for navigation up the Rio Negro to the indigenous community, where they will be welcomed by the Pajé and other members of the community who will perform a ritual with dances and music played by instruments made by themselves. They will have the opportunity to see the way of life of these indigenous people, taste some of the delicacies consumed by them and even dance with them. A delicious lunch will be served inside the indigenous community with indigenous spices. After the visit, return to Manaus by speedboat and later by vehicle to the hotel.

#### Day 6 –Amazon

Breakfast and check out at hotel.

#### Transfer from Manaus Hotel to Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge (Shared Transfer – Duration: 03 hours)

Transfer by air-conditioned car, approximately 3h00, to Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge.

Arrival in lodge, and check in.

Welcome cocktail reception, accommodation and lodge recognition.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner included.

#### Day 7 and Day 8 - Amazon

Breakfast, and activities in lodge.

The order of the tours above is defined by the Hotel, which will supply the schedule of the activities upon guest arrival.

#### Canoeing through the Igapós and Igarapés

Hear the sounds of the forest and explore the rivers. In canoes for up to 2 people, you can watch the scenery changing as you paddle along waters and between trees.

#### Visit the local Community

Canoe trip on Rio Negro and visit to a local caboclo community. Get to know their lifestyle, traditions, agriculture and social organization.

#### Anavilhanas Archipelago Nocturnal Sightseeing

Enjoy the unique feeling of the nightlife inside the forest, lightened by the stars, exploring the igapós to spot birds, sloths, snakes and alligators hidden in the sounds of darkness.

#### Recognition tour on the Archipelago

Regional ships are used to explore the countless canals, lakes and islands of this beautiful archipelago – one of the largest in the world.

#### Hiking on Dryland Forests

Led by experienced local guides, explore areas that are not affected by floods – the firm forests or dryland forests. During the tour, learn about trees, fruits and wild fruits, survival strategies and medicinal herbs.

#### Visit to Pink River Dolphins and the Handicraft fair in Novo Airao

Visit a floating deck where Pink River Dolphins come close searching for food. Then, meander through the arts and crafts center where artisans make decoration items and toys with wood, straw and seeds.

#### Recreational Piranha Fishing

Enjoy the amazing scenery and catch some fish during this fun activity done in wooden canoes along the igarapés.

#### Sunrise Contemplation

Leaving at dawn, the guest will be taken to the islands to watch the birds flying and the beauty of all the colors when the sun rises in the Amazon sky.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included.

#### Day 9 - Amazon - Departure

Breakfast and check out at lodge.

#### Transfer from Manaus Hotel to Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge (Shared Transfer – Duration: 03 hours)

Transfer by air-conditioned car, approximately 3h00 from Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge to Manaus International Airport.

#### End of the services.

#### Important Informations about the Transfers to Anavilhanas Jungle lodge:

**Transfer:** The Regular Transfer service (included in the rate) is offered daily at 2 fixed times. The route is by paved road in Vans or Cars and take an average of three (3) hours.

Transfer In (Manaus-Lodge):

- First Transfer: between 08:00am and 09:00am with pick-up at hotels,
- Second Transfer: between 13:30 and 14:30 for flights arriving until 14:15 on Airport. During the summer time, we service flights that arrive before 13:15 departing to the lodge from 13:00 to 13:30. For passengers coming straight from the airport guests will miss the lunch and first activity of the package.

Transfer Out - Return Transfer (Lodge-Manaus):

- Frist Return Transfer: Departs lodge at 08:00 for flights between 13:00 and 19:00
- Second Return Transfer: Departs Lodge at 14:00 flights after 19:00 and Hotels in Manaus. We recommend arriving 2hs in advance for check-ins in Manaus. Opting for morning departure the guest will lose the last activity of the package.

Round trip private transfers are available for an additional cost.

For security reasons, the lodge does not operate transfers, even if private, leaving Manaus or the Lodge after 16:00. Therefore for those who have flights arriving after 16:00 (4:00Pm) in Manaus, the guest must overnight in Manaus and head to the Lodge in the morning the next day.
