MONUMENTAL CALLAO

Callao rose to prominence as one of the most influential sea ports in all the colonies of Spanish America. For centuries, it was a center for investment in the form of splendid architecture and cutting-edge infrastructure. However, Callao's affluence began to fade in the 20th century, and it acquired a hostile reputation defined by violence, poverty, and social decline.

Today, private investors are working on the renewal of Callao through the positive influence of art and culture. Led by the "Fugaz" ("Shooting Star") project, the aim is to transform previously dangerous and dilapidated streets into living works of art.

During a guided tour through Callao's streets, you will be able to admire some of the murals that have become a symbol of the district's new beginning.

You will also visit a local micro-museum of art installations, in the company of guides with personal experience of the changes in the area, having been gang members themselves in the past.
