

ENJOY CANOEING ON THE LEGENDARY LAKE TITICACA

Try something altogether new and exciting by rowing traditional Polynesian canoes, across the waters of the world's highest navigable lake: Titicaca. At a height of 3,812 meters above sea level and covering a surface area of 8,500sg km, canoeing Titicaca is a complete one-off adventure!

So, having ticked off all safety measures and been set up with the necessary gear, we will hop aboard our canoes and make for the floating islands of Uros.

Throughout, be sure to take advantage of your unique lakelocked position and photograph these extraordinary surroundings whenever possible; as an infinite blue sky merges with the sapphire waters below. All the while, imposing snow-topped peaks stand guard over these tranquil scenes, punctuated as they are with stretches of beach and resident wildlife too. Along the way, you'll be granted peaceful, uninterrupted views of the landscape by taking routes that avoid those of local boats, rowing along canals flanked by totora reeds to eventually moor up at one of the Uros Islands.
