



CLASS AT SEMINARIO'S WORKSHOP

Discovering pre-Columbian art

Just 90 minutes from the city of Cusco, in the heart of the Sacred Valley of the Incas, is the charming home which also serves as the workshop and exhibition space of the renowned ceramist Pablo Seminario and his wife Marilú Behar.

Discover a new artistic expression -the fruit of more than 35 years of research- based upon the techniques and styles of pre-Columbian pottery-making, but also the product of the artist's own expressive form, which has come to be known as the Seminario Style.

Participate in a fascinating ceramic painting class, lasting around 2 hours, during which you will be encouraged to create your own design from a ceramic plaque measuring 10 x 10 centimeters (3.93 x 3.93 inches).

The pieces made during this class are sun-dried before being fired in a kiln, after which they will be sent to your hotel in Cusco, carefully packaged for transporting.
