Exploring the living culture of Peru

In Cusco, very close to the Sacred Valley of the Incas, the Quechua community of Cuyuni will open its doors and allow you to be part of their daily life, by introducing you to the activities of the village and inviting you to participate.

Receive a traditional welcome with musicians from the community and, along with the villagers, tour the community and enjoy the beautiful surrounding landscape.

Witness ancestral rituals such as offerings to Mother Earth or the thanksgiving made to the sacred mountains known as Apus*; learn about local farming and livestock work; and try "huatia", a meal made from potatoes and other local produce, cooked in the earth.

And enjoy the Llama Pilluy presentation, a unique celebration in which participants dance with their llamas, reflecting just how important their livestock is to this traditional community.

And before leaving the village, learn more about the local textilemaking process and watch skilled weavers at work, spinning, dyeing and weaving wool on their looms, after which you'll be invited to enjoy a delicious lunch made with local ingredients.
