Añashuayco, "where the fox dwells", is the name of the ravine that is home to the quarries that have supplied "sillar", a white stone of volcanic origin, to the White City since colonial times.

Situated between the slopes of Mount Chachani volcano and the right bank of the Chili River, this ravine is filled with majesty and mystery. Wander through the quarries and witness the skills of the master quarrymen who continue to use extraction methods and tools brought from Europe by the Spanish during the colonial period that have been passed on from one generation to the next.
