KAYAKING

This adventure will offer you a quiet experience as you paddle near the river bank, the perfect combination of adventure and wildlife



STAND UP PADDLING

Paddle boarding is easy, fun and a great way to explore the river as quietly as possible. We will have great opportunities to find wildlife



CANOPY CLIMBING

The canopy of the rainforest is where most of the action takes place. This activity brings you up into this exciting, little known realm



MOUNTAIN BIKING

If you like action these is a great way to explore and experience the beauty and excitement of the rainforest along ten kilometers of trails



CHUNCHO CLAY LICK

Take a half day excursion to the second largest macaw clay lick in the area and observe this amazing, colorful, natural spectacle



SUNSET CRUISE

Sunsets in the jungle are beautiful spectacles from nature and one of the best places to enjoy it is from a boat on the Tambopata River.



THE BIG GRID

Camera Traps will give us the opportunity of "watching" what is happening out there. We will help collecting data and installing new ones



AEROBOTANY

We will get to the top of the trees and learn about the research we are doing with drones, great pictures and videos from the top!



BARCODING TAMBOPATA

We'll help researchers to find new species. A short hike from the lodge will take us to a light tramp where we'll help collect and identify them

CIRCLE OF FIRE

Sitting on a circle of fire and listen a story is the starting point for the adventure that awaits us in our children activities.



RAINFOREST TATTOO

We will prepare a paste from the "huito" fruit, achiote or other natural dyes to draw tattoos on ourselves that last for some days.



THE CHILDREN'S TRAIL

An exciting journey designed for children, we go thru a walk where we follow maps, solve riddles and find clues.



CAIMAN SEARCH

Caiman's hunts at night so we'll get out at the river's edge, and scan the shores with headlamps to catch the reflection caiman's eyes.



OXBOW LAKE

Paddle a traditional canoe or a catamaran looking for lakeside wildlife. You will also be rewarded with overhead sightings of macaws and amazing skies.



CANOPY TOWER

Let's get the eagle's view of the forest. This hike leads us to the 35 meter scaffolding canopy tower.



FARM VISIT

Family owned farm managed by charismatic Don Manuel. He grows a variety of popular and little known Amazonian crops.



ETHNOBOTANICAL TOUR

Along this trail we will find a diversity of plants and trees that are used by the local people for a variety of purposes.



RAINFOREST LECTURES

Nightly lectures prepared by the staff of the lodge cover conservation threats and projects in the Tambopata National Reserve

PARAKEET CLAY LICK

A 15 min boat ride and 60 min hike from the lodge will take us to a clay lick where you may see some parakeets descend to ingest the clay on a bank.



MAMMAL CLAY LICK

Other wildlife feed on clay too. This hike will take us to a blind next to a mammal's clay lick. Chances of spotting them are rare but well worth the hike.



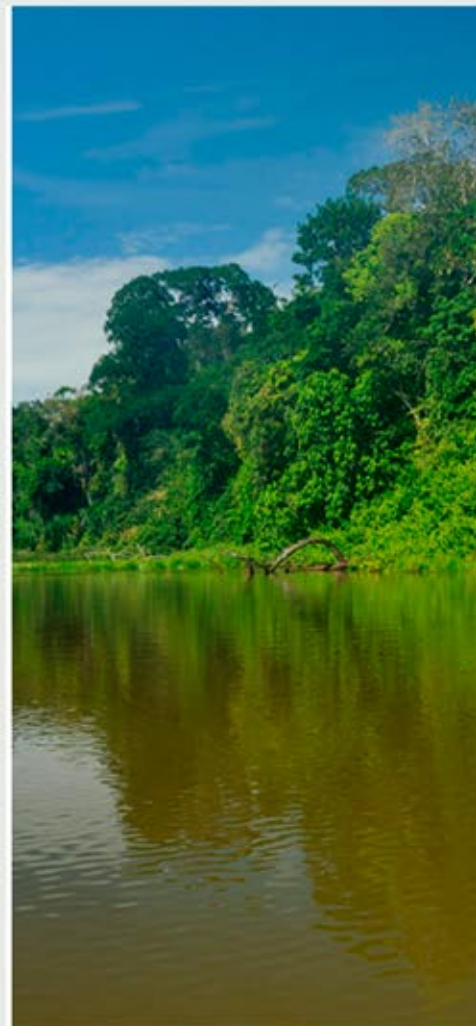
NIGHT WALK
